ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be a resident of Iroquois County
2. Applicants must be a full time student

NOMINATION PROCESS

1. Applications must be complete and accompanied by the correct biographical information, transcript, and a statement of educational and career goals.
2. The high school Guidance Counselor, Principal, and/or teacher, superintendent will nominate the student from their respective school and then send on to the Iroquois County Soil and Water for final selection(s) from all the schools that send a nominee by Friday, April 1st, 2011.

DISBURSEMENT

1. Recipients will be awarded their \$500.00 from the Iroquois County Pheasants Forever when an enrollment letter for second semester and a letter of good standing is received by the Iroquois County Soil and Water Conservation District. They will be awarded a plaque at the Awards Program at their local school and recognized at the Iroquois County Soil and Water Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet which is held in February.
