

William A. Goetting Scholarship

In the interest of Paxton-Buckley-Loda High School students furthering their education, the family of William A. Goetting, a school board member at the time of his death, is offering a scholarship to a student who wishes to further his or her education by attending a trade school or a two year Career Program in a Junior College such as Parkland. The recipient must be a full time student. The size of the award will be \$500.

Basics Qualification: The recipient should be a Senior student in good academic standing and graduating when the award is announced. The recipient must be able to show an interest in the chosen field of study by answers on the application.

The School Committee will select the recipient and inform the Goetting family. The chosen recipient will be announced at graduation.

The award will be given to the student and the chosen school. One half the award will be given at the beginning of the first semester. The rest will be given for the second semester after the student has decided to continue.

The completed application must be turned into The School Counselor by May 1.
