PBL

Student registration for grades Kindergarten – 8th will be held on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 from 12:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. in the Paxton-Buckley-Loda Junior High Commons Area. Student registration for grades 9th – 12th will be held on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 in the High School Little Assembly from 12:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Registration after August 8, 2017 for all grades will take place at each grade center Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. through the first day of school.

Student registration fees are as follows:	Elementary (K-5)	\$ 85.00

The District will accept Discover, VISA, and Mastercard credit cards to pay for registration and lunch fees.

JUNIOR HIGH:

Junior High students wishing to participate in IESA athletics must have a sports physical prior to try-outs and practices and must sign an insurance waiver or purchase insurance at a cost of \$294.00 economy or \$435.00 basic insurance.

HIGH SCHOOL:

High School students wishing to participate in IHSA football must have a sports physical prior to practice and sign an insurance waiver or purchase football insurance at a cost of \$294.00 economy or \$435.00 basic insurance. High School students wishing to participate in all other athletic events must sign an insurance waiver or purchase insurance and have a sports physical prior to try-outs or attending practices. All PBL High School students participating in IHSA extra-curricular activities and their parents/guardians will need to sign a consent form for random drug testing.

Athletic waivers and school insurance information will be available at registration or online at www.pblunit10.com.

All students enrolling in drivers education at PBL High School will be required to pay a one-time fee of \$150.00, and any student enrolling in advanced placement or dual credit courses at PBL High School will be required to pay a fee of \$30.00.

The first day of student attendance will be Thursday, August 17, 2017. This will be an early dismissal day with Clara Peterson Elementary and Eastlawn Elementary dismissing at 2:20 p.m., PBL High School dismissing at 2:25 p.m., and PBL Junior High dismissing at 2:30 p.m.

All student lunches may be purchased on a daily basis or you may credit student lunch accounts at registration for future purchases. EARLY DISMISSAL:

PBL will dismiss early each Tuesday the entire school year beginning on Tuesday, August 22, 2017. Clara Peterson Elementary and Eastlawn Elementary dismissing at 2:20 p.m., PBL High School dismissing at 2:25 p.m., and PBL Junior High dismissing at 2:30 p.m.

Health Compliancy: Students not in compliance by having the required exams completed and submitted to the school office prior to [Friday, October 13, 2017](#) will be excluded from school until all exams and immunizations are completed. A signed note from the physician, dentist, or the ophthalmologist office with the date of the scheduled appointment will be accepted as temporary compliance until the actual appointment date.

All incoming Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6th grade, and 9th grade students are required by law to have a school physical prior to starting the school year. This includes up-to-date immunizations recorded on the physical form. It is also required that the parent portion of the physical form is completed and signed by a parent (not the student). In addition to the physical, incoming Kindergarten, 2nd grade, and 6th grade students are required to have a dental examination. Kindergarten students are also required to have an eye exam (to be done by an ophthalmologist or optometrist) to be on file by [Friday, October 13, 2017](#).

All incoming 12 Grade students are required to have two (2) doses of meningococcal vaccine.

Student Transportation: PBL provides transportation services between the elementary buildings and junior high/high school campuses. Schedules for this shuttle service will be available at registration. PBL also provides rural bus service for those students living further than 1.50 miles from any grade center. The District contracts student transportation services with Illinois Central School Bus (ICSB). Representatives from ICSB will be present at registration to assist parents and students with any transportation questions. You may reach ICSB representatives at the bus garage at (217) 379-4500.
